The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local Union 163 and the PEN-DEL-JERSEY chapter of the National Electrical Contractors Association announce the acceptance of applications for its Jointly operated Apprenticeship and Training Program (JATC).

Minimum requirements for applicants are: Must be a minimum of 18 years of age, high school graduate or GED, completion of one year high school algebra with a passing grade or equivalent, receive a satisfactory score on the JATC administered aptitude test, and reside in the Local 163 jurisdiction. Must possess a valid driver's license, pass a background check and physical exam. Pre-indenture and random drug testing is required.

All apprentices selected for the program are required to complete not less than 8,000 hours of on-the-job training and 900 hours of related classroom instruction for a minimum of five years. Apprentices will be selected without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin.
